PORTABLE TOILETS



Our standard jobsite portable toilet service and cleaning is performed **once a week**.



If once weekly service isn't adequate for your volume of use, we recommend adding a second or third portable toilet to the jobsite. In many instances, we can add extra service and cleaning days to your schedule **but it comes at a higher cost per service**.



Any extra or emergency servicing, including tipovers, will result in a **\$50-\$100 charge** depending on location.

DUE TO FLUCTUATING FUEL PRICES: We are temporarily applying a surcharge to the cost of the rental.



Please call our office when you need a portable toilet delivered or removed and we'll schedule it for the next time we are in your area.

If you need the portable toilet delivered or removed outside of our designated delivery/removal days, we will do our best to accommodate you, but in most cases there will be a \$50 fee.



The Nauset Disposal team takes tremendous pride in the service and equipment we provide. Please ensure that those using our equipment extend the same respect as if they were using your tools or equipment.

DO'S



Choose a location for the portable toilet that our truck can access for the weekly servicing.



Leave a parking spot open no more than 10'-15' away from the portable toilet for our service truck.



Have the portable toilet accessible on the day of service.



Move the portable toilets by hand if they must be moved.

DON'TS



DO NOT block access to the portable toilet on service days.



DO NOT turn the truck away or else the portable toilet won't be serviced until the following week's scheduled servicing. Go-Back servicing is available for an extra fee.



DO NOT put any trash in the portable toilet tank that's not bath tissue.



DO NOT attempt to move or drag the portable toilet with heavy machinery or power equipment.



DO NOT mark or damage the portable toilet in any way. Damage beyond normal wear and tear will generate a repair charge based on the cost of repair.
